If your child(ren) will be arriving late, please make sure to sign in so that we can adjust their attendance.

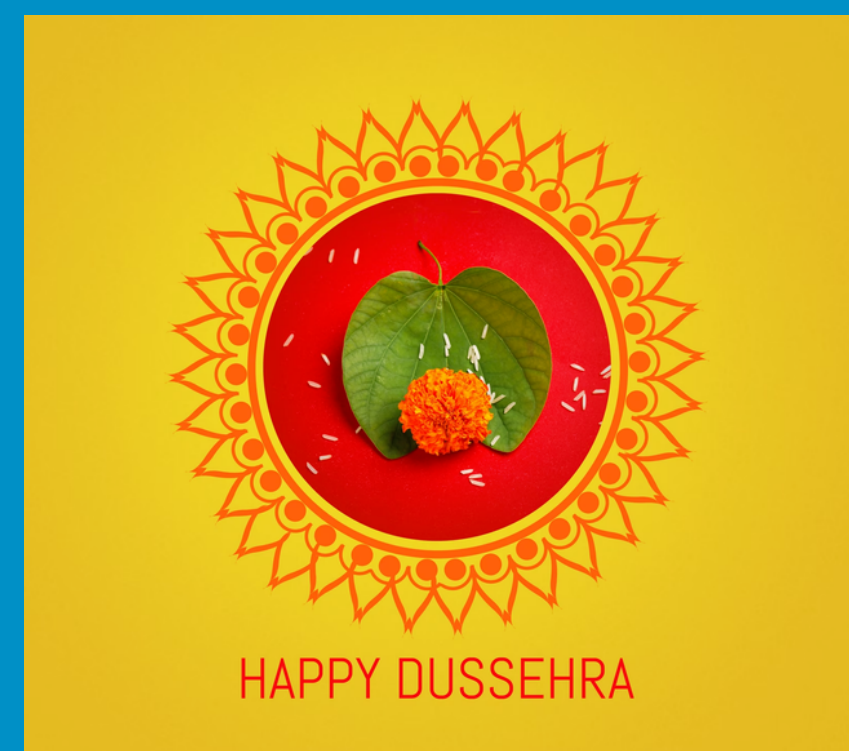

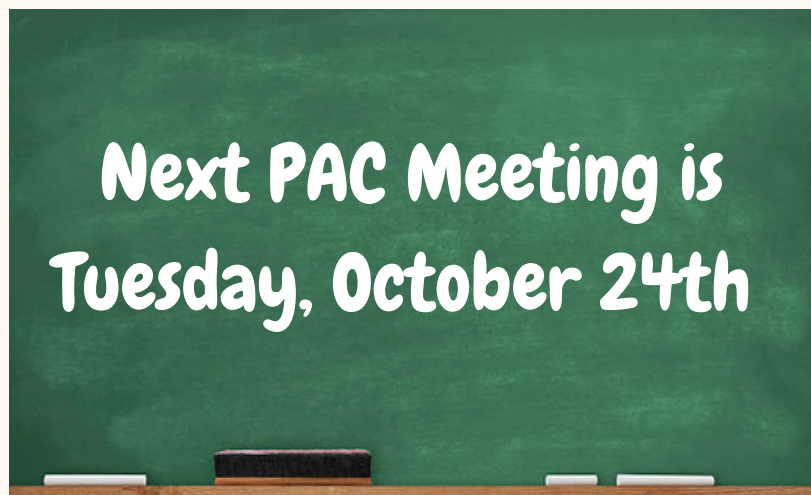
