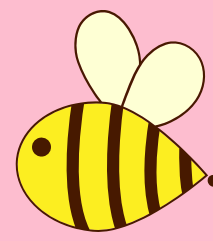

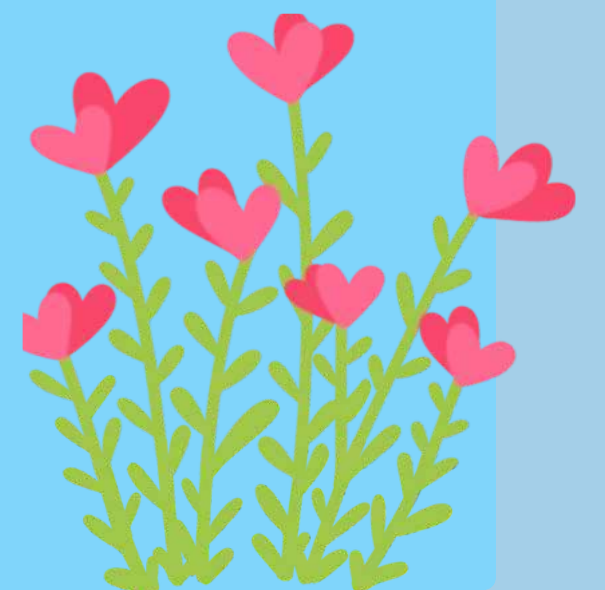

Homma's First Comic-Con: Division 7 Brings Kindness to Life!

This year marked an exciting milestone at Tomekichi Homma Elementary as Division 7 proudly hosted the very first Homma Comic Convention! The event also helped celebrate 10 years of Comic-Con creativity at Westwind Elementary, bringing our school community together through storytelling, imagination, and—most importantly—kindness.

The journey began ten weeks ago, when students set out to create their very own original comics. Along the way, they explored the art of comic storytelling through mini-lessons, drafts, proposal presentations, and even logo design. Step by step, their ideas evolved into unique characters and stories ready to share with an audience.

One special challenge guided their work: each comic needed to explore kindness. Students created stories where two characters discuss why kindness matters. Before putting pencil to paper, the class reflected together on a big question: “Why is kindness important?”

The answers were thoughtful, creative, and wide-ranging. From helping others feel included, to making someone's day brighter, students discovered that kindness can take many forms. Using their growing knowledge of comic and graphic features—speech bubbles, panels, expressions, and sound effects—they brought these ideas vividly to life.

When convention day finally arrived, the excitement was clear. Division 7 transformed their classroom into a comic showcase, proudly sharing their finished creations. Other classes from the school came to visit, explore the comics, and celebrate the students' hard work.

Throughout their comic journey, students didn't just learn about storytelling. They also practiced valuable life skills such as perseverance and patience. During the convention, students shared their work, offered positive feedback, and celebrated each other's creativity.

The first Homma Comic Convention was a wonderful success, showing that when creativity and kindness come together, amazing stories can happen.
