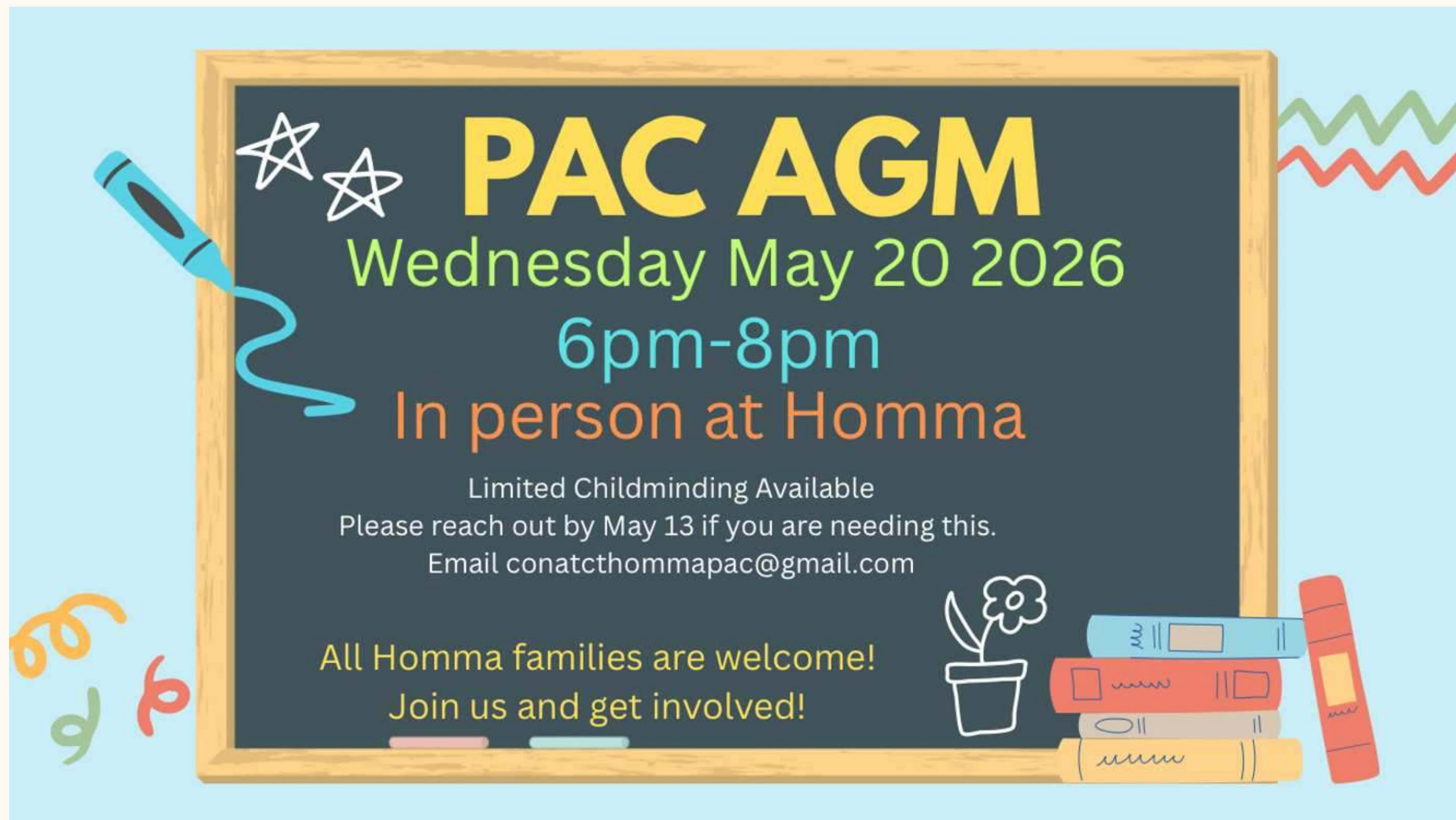

Our PAC's Annual General Meeting (AGM) is coming up soon, and all parents and guardians are warmly invited and encouraged to attend! The AGM is an important opportunity to hear updates, share ideas, and help shape the direction of our school community.

During the meeting, all positions on the Parent Advisory Council (PAC) will be open for election. Getting involved with the PAC is a great way to contribute to school initiatives, support student activities, and have a voice in decisions that impact our children's learning environment.

We encourage anyone interested to consider putting their name forward—no prior experience is necessary, just a willingness to participate and collaborate.

Here is a list of the positions that are mandatory (as per funding bylaws) with brief descriptions of the roles.

Chair: The Chair provides guidance, support and overall vision for the PAC. Responsibilities include communication with admin, preparing meeting agendas, chairing meetings, oversight of event proposals and functions and operating the PAC email. The Chair works with the Hot Lunch Team to troubleshoot and collaborate on issues that come up.

Secretary: The Secretary takes minutes of all PAC meetings (taking attendance, notes and voting). Reports from treasurer and admin are usually available and can be copied and pasted. The Secretary is responsible for posting the minutes to the website in draft mode and final acceptance. The Secretary is also to submit the Week at a Glance (WAAG) every week to the school admin after collecting input from PAC execs.

Treasurer: The Treasurer responsibly and accurately manages the PAC's finances, including, but not limited to, weekly, monthly, and yearly tasks. Estimated time commitment: Minimum 165 hrs / year. Avg. 3 hrs/wk, plus 15+ annual hrs budget analyzing & report writing, plus supporting and attending events, plus monthly (minimum) trips to the bank.

Additional roles may include Vice-Chair, Fundraising Coordinators, RDPA Rep and Parent Education Coordinator.
