We are very proud of our Homma Community! We were able to raise a total of \$1,875.25 in donations for the Terry Fox Foundation. All money raised goes towards cancer research.








The Pass is now available to all Richmond students registered in Grade 5, including those home-schooled or attending private schools.

Foundation Skills Assessment

Each year students in Grades 4 and 7 participate in the Foundation Skills Assessment. The assessment consists of a written and on-line component. Students are assessed in literacy and numeracy. The assessment provides a snapshot of student learning currently and provides the school with information about strengths and stretches in these areas. The assessment results are not used to determine written update comments, but do provide families with another opportunity to see how their child is doing. The best source of information, however, continues to be your child's classroom teacher.




Get Ready for a Spooktacular Halloween Dance!
