Library Books

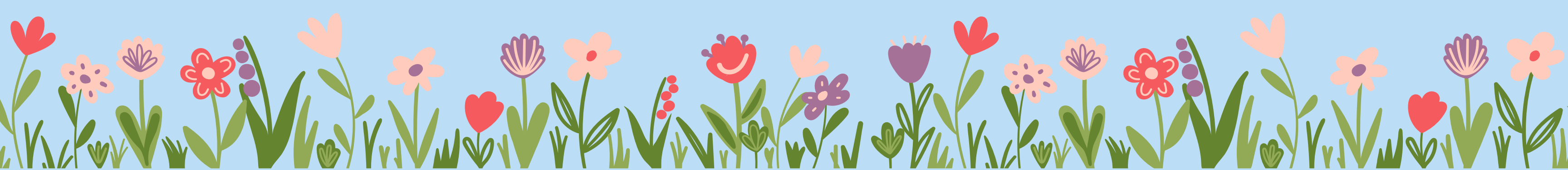
ALL library books are to be returned to the school library by Monday, June 16.

There will be a cost for any lost, misplaced or damaged books



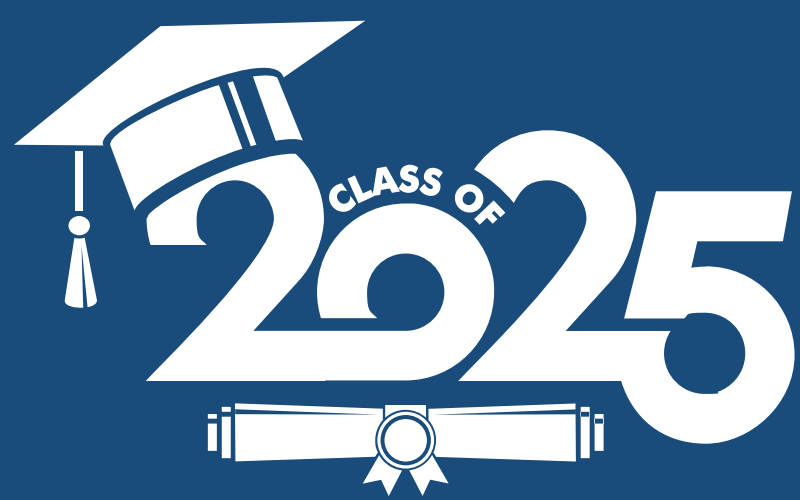
Freezies are back!
