A Message from the Garden

Your Dear Families,

As we move through the fall and winter seasons, we want to remind everyone that students play outside for both recess and lunch in all weather. Fresh air and active play are important parts of our day, rain or shine!

Please ensure your child has weather appropriate clothing everyday. Waterproof jackets, boots, warm layers, and a change of clothes can make a big difference in helping students stay comfortable and enjoy their time outside.

A helpful visual guide of "what to wear in wet weather" is included in this newsletter.

Our school strives to ensure that all students feel comfortable and cared for throughout the day. To support this, we provide a Outdoor Gear Lending Library for students who may not have their own gear, or who left it at home, this is mainly used by the outdoor classroom and garden program, but students do have access to use it for recess and lunch as well.

Many more children than usual have been using the lending library these past few rainy weeks, as they are not coming to school prepared to be outside in the rain, and we are not able to keep items available for those students who need it.

Your support in helping your child arriving to school with the wet weather gear they need is very helpful to maintain the lending library for everyone.

If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the school.

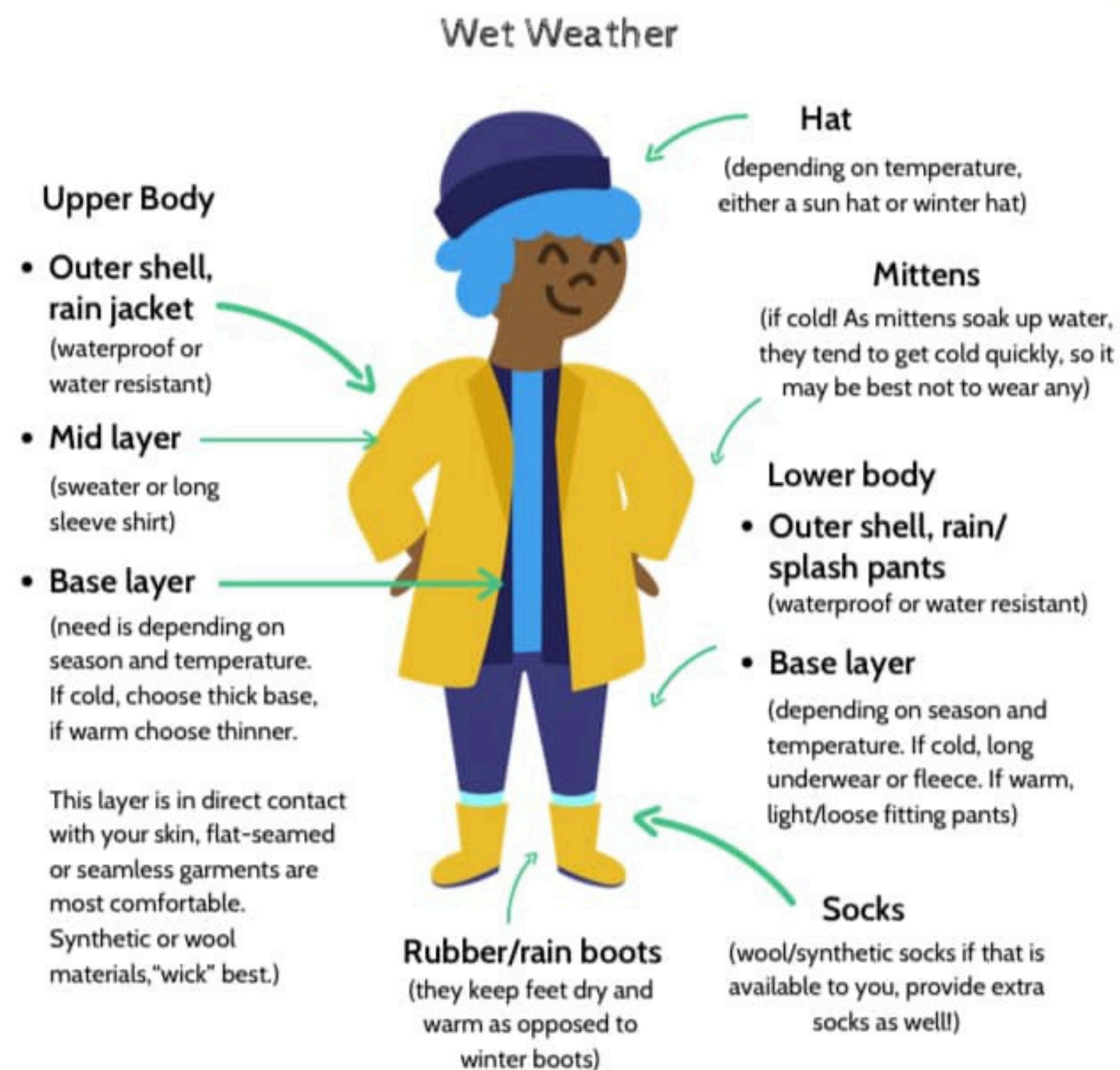

HELPFUL TIPS

- For educators, pack the following extra gear when in your kit/when out on a hike:
 - socks, mittens, 2-3 pairs of rubber boots, handful of grocery bags (these can be used to prevent further wetness, as they act as a protective layer in rubber boots/winter boots against further seepage. They can keep the new dry socks dry!)
