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<p>7:00 - 7:25 pm</p>	<p>Treasurer's Report Homma PAC Meeting, January 22nd, 2026</p> <p>November and December 2025, into January 2026:</p> <p>The season of quiet financial housekeeping has returned to the Homma PAC.</p> <p>In December, we deposited the proceeds from the following fundraisers, all led by Fundraising Coordinators Madeleine Wareing and Joanne Belda:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Family Photos Fundraiser: \$812.90 2. Art Cards by Kids: \$2,679.27 3. Winter Wonderland Fundraiser: an estimated \$1,000, pending final expenses; and 4. \$312.00 raised from the Winter Wonderland Raffle went into our Gaming Account, to fund Gaming-eligible PAC initiatives. <p>Particular congratulations to Madeleine and Joanne on the success of the Art Cards fundraiser. The money generated from the Art Cards represents just over half of the \$5,000 we provided to subsidize Jess Dance, who led our kids in two weeks of dance workshops in December.</p> <p>Ongoing Events</p> <p>Hot Lunch ordering for Terms Two and Three is open on the Hot Lunch website. This year we are offering an additional Hot Lunch date in Term Two, for a total of five; and nine Hot Lunch dates in Term Three. We continue to offer a limited number of Hot Lunch servings available as cash-based concession sales as an option for families. 7:50 - 8:00 pm	<p>New/Other Business</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Change of photographer: Photos come not cut to size. Edge is used by most of the schools. Quality of photos is mostly satisfactory and the school has already committed for the next year. Edge is good from a customer service and the photographers are good —> school has a good relationship with them. Admin can ask whether they can do the cutting. It is possible that the pricing is going up because of that. ● Performance at the end of dance lessons: Should consider the participation in the performance as optional but not mandatory. Admin offers to have an individual discussion on individual situations. Also it is encouraged to reach out to the teachers to explain individual situation. ● Using gaming funds to purchase annual movie license for PAC only usage. Would need min of 2 movie nights in a 12 month period to have better cost ratio than purchasing individual licenses. Suggestion is to purchase the license close to the next movie night to maximize the available 12 month period. Miranda will call Gaming to clarify whether a movie license is qualifying for gaming funding.
